IN REMEMBRANCE ...



Prof U R Rao was instrumental in designing the first Indian satellite 'Aryabhatta''. Under his leadership as Chairman ISRO, launch vehicles have made enormous progress, including PSLV and initiation of cryogenic stage of GSLV. Besides several scientific achievements, he was conferred with Padma-Vibhushan – the second highest civilian award in the country.



Prof Yash Pal was the first Director of SAC, Ahmedabad after it was constituted in 1973. By profession he was a cosmic ray scientists and held key positions in DST, UGC and Planning Commission. He was instrumental in setting up IUCAA (Pune), which is one of its kind in the country. Dr Yash Pal was known for his role in popularisation of science.



Dr K N Shakara was former Director of SAC and ISRO Satellite Centre (ISAC), Bengaluru. Electrical communication specialist by education, he was responsible for development of INSAT satellites and microwave sensors. He was later involved in development and direction of India's communication satellite programme.
